BS PSYCHOLOGY

This degree course trains students in the scientific study of human behavior and mental processes, exposing them to various areas which include research, testing, counseling, human resources development and management, organizational behavior, developmental, abnormal behavior, physiology, educational & cognitive psychology, and personality theories.

The degree qualifies a student to take the Psychometrician Licensure Exam or to take graduate level specializations in IO Psychology, Counseling, Law or Medicine.



Master in PSYCHOLOGY

The program provides the students with theoretical and research foundations on human behaviors in the work setting. The students have two tracks to choose from; Counseling Psychology or Organizational Psychology. MA in GUIDANCE AND COUNSELING

This non thesis program prepares the students to take the licensure examination for Guidance Counselors. Students are expected to undergo mastery of counseling principles and related subject areas such as personality and human development.
